What is Home Shield?

Home Shield is a cross-agency referral service, for vulnerable and older people and their carers.

The service is supported and coordinated through a group of partner agencies whose aim is to find ways to enable people to stay safe, healthy and happy in their own homes.

The kinds of things these partner agencies help with are:

Health and well-being

- * Reducing hospital admissions
- * Helping you live independently in your own home
- * Identifying problems before they become acute
- Referring people with unmet needs to the right support services

Income

 Checking that you are receiving the income and benefits to which you are entitled

Daily living

- Ensuring you get regular hot meals and help with grocery shopping
- Advising on how to keep your house warm and have access to hot water

 Helping you to have regular contact with other people.

Security and safety

- Ensuring you are able to secure your house against unwelcome visitors
- Helping you protect yourself from scams or other forms of "rogue" trading
- * Ensuring you have a working smoke alarm
- Checking for any fire or trip hazards in your home

How Home Shield works

If a professional, in the course of their ordinary business, finds that you have a need which they cannot address but which could be fulfilled by another organisation, they can refer it to Home Shield, the cross-agency referral service.

The professional will briefly explain Home Shield to you and complete the referral form.

You will then be requested to sign the form in order to show that you have agreed to your details being referred to partner agencies.
