Presentation of the Strategy

The Executive Directors have worked collectively on the four strategic themes; Partnering, Growing, People and Excelling and each presented their specific area of the strategy.

ECCH Shareholding

The report for June shows that ECCH has 81% shareholding and there continues to be a good uptake from new staff joining ECCH.

Report of visits

Tony Osmanski, Rachel Lilley and Ian Morrison visited Gorleston PCN on 11th June; this was very positively received by the staff and there are plans for the Non-Executive Directors to visit all of the PCNs. The Non-Executive Directors will also plan to visit other ECCH teams across the locality.
