Exploring the role of digital technology within a community neurology service: a service evaluation project

Sarah Lauchlan, Team Lead Physiotherapist, Integrated Community Neurology Team, attended the Board meeting to provide a presentation on a service evaluation project. Digital transformation has been identified as a key component of future healthcare provision, in both national and local strategies. Utilising digital technology can improve health outcomes, increase efficiency and empower patients with self-management. The community neurology service at East Coast Community Healthcare (ECCH) supports over 1800 patients with long-term conditions. Digital transformation offers a potential solution to manage increasing demand, and an opportunity to enhance the quality of the service.
